

Sunday is a day of worship at Kifula. People are expected to spend 30 percent of their day in worship. There is a single worship service on Sunday, followed by Sunday school and the bible studies. Worship is to start at 10 am sharp, which in Africa time means that it starts when everyone is ready, which was several minutes after 10 am. Worship at Kifula lasts about 3 hours. The service we attended was divided into:

- Forgiveness of sins
- Restoration to membership of a young man who had fallen into a life of crime and had now repented.
- Period of introduction where Pastor Kissimbo spoke and Silas introduced their guests
- Gospel
- Sermon: Pastor Dave gave the sermon, which was translated to Swahili by Charles.
- 3 offerings
- Pastor Miraro, the retired pastor of Kifula, spoke briefly to help explain Pastor Dave's sermon
- Sending
- Auction

The music was a mixture of traditional German Lutheran hymns and African hymns. The Kifula choirs are wonderful.
